

**Applying for an Arnold Weeks Memorial Scholarship
At St. Peter Evangelical Lutheran Church**

GUIDELINES

1. Applicants must be a documented member (either by confirmation or transfer) at St Peter Lutheran Church and/or have been active in the life of the congregation as a child/youth.
2. Applicant must show proof of current registration in the institution they attend.
3. A student must maintain a GPA of 2.0 or better. Please provide an unofficial transcript.
4. A student may attend a trade school, technical school, college, university or seminary, and is not required to be in a degree program to receive a scholarship.
5. The average first time scholarship is \$1500. Amounts awarded may be different each year depending upon the number of applications received and the total funds available.
6. A student may apply for a scholarship more than once, but subsequent scholarships will be less than the initial grant. All post high-school students are encouraged to apply.
7. Applications should be well presented to the Gifts and Memorial Team of St. Peter. The team reserves the right to refuse any application or to return it for resubmission.
8. High school students should not apply until after they finish their first semester of college. Applications will be accepted and grants will be awarded in the spring semester.
